FROM PASTOR RALPH...



ne of the best things about following Jesus is living a life of lasting purpose. True purpose is knowing God and loving Him, becoming the person He created you to be, and making a difference in the lives of people around you who will all exist somewhere

for eternity. This year, as never before, we have powerful opportunities to intentionally live our purpose.

If you haven't turned in your *Plan for Spiritual Growth*, please do this Sunday (drop it in a communication card basket). The nature of life is such that if we don't intentionally plan to live God's purpose, we probably won't.

In less than six weeks, March 19-22, is our main event of the year, the *Spiritual Life Conference*. We ask everyone at Harvest to set this time aside to seek God to move in your own life, in our church, and in our region. God honors time dedicated to Him, and at times He has poured out His Spirit in ways that have altered history and transformed nations. Ask God to increase your hunger and faith for a transforming encounter with Him! Ask the five people you are praying for daily to join you on Sunday morning or any evening during the conference.

Invite everyone you can to *Easter* services on April 16. More people go to church on Easter than on any other Sunday. At Harvest our attendance almost doubles on Easter, which makes it the best opportunity of the year to get people to come to church. And every year many who come begin a relationship with Jesus and their eternity is changed!

The city-wide *Will Graham Celebration* on May 5-7 is another opportunity to bring those you are praying for to Christ. Evangelism and Prayer Ministry training begins Saturday, March 25 (3 sessions in 3 weeks; no cost). The Billy Graham Evangelism Association will show how to effectively lead people to Christ and pray with them.

As I think about these opportunities to impact our world, I'm impressed that 100,000 years from now we could be talking about the lives that were changed because of the events of these next 4 1/2 months. Let the Lord use you, live for an eternal purpose, and "make the most of every opportunity" (Ephesians 5:16).
