arvest is a large church; we have the opportunity to do some incredible things. Each year we have three large conferences: Spiritual Life (spring), Youth (summer), and Fall Renewal. Many ministries have started out of Harvest both locally and

internationally. We are able to give a substantial amount to global missions and local missions. We can also do extra cool things like have nice lights, livestream our services, and keep our lawns looking in tip top shape. All of these have a place of importance in the Kingdom of God. Nevertheless, the most important thing we do is make disciples.

Even before Harvest was a large church, we were committed to making disciples. Jesus gave us this mission (Matt 28:19), and how we accomplish it makes the difference of whether or not our church is successful and whether or not you are successful in this life.

I recently read an outstanding pamphlet written years ago by Dawson Trotman called "Born to Multiply." In it he tells the story of a young man he discipled and sent off to his naval ship to make disciples of others. The young man quickly gathered a decent sized group and began discipling them. He became discouraged when he faced a lack of commitment from the group. He went back to Dawson to get answers, and Dawson gave him these words: "Before you have two, you must have one." The young man went back to his ship, found one person who was eager to become a disciple of Jesus Christ, and taught him everything he knew. By the end of World War II there were men on 1,000 navy ships following Jesus that could be traced back to the young man who found his one. So quite simply I ask the question, "Where is your one?"

In the last three years, have you made a disciple? If so, who is it and what are they doing now? Maybe it is through our discipleship phases, small groups, or just in a simple one-on-one setting. However it may happen, let us keep to the mission of making disciples.

HOW YOUR GIVING IS CHANGING THE WORLD

Harvest Church is glad to be a long-term partner with **Wycliffe Associates**. The vision of Wycliffe is that there are hundreds of millions of people without God's Word in their heart language. Their continued goal since 1967 is to see every verse translated into every tongue to reach every heart. Last year, Wycliffe staff and volunteers worked in 76 countries to speed Bible translations by providing technology, volunteers, discipleship, and church planting.

One exciting new program is Wycliffe's MAST Program that began in 2014. Using new technology, the New Testament is now available in 58 new languages, with 100 more translations nearing completion. Many of these translations are being made in nations where Christians are experiencing ongoing persecution.

Language/Translation Facts:

- Languages currently spoken in the world: 7,097
- Languages that need a Bible translation project started: 3,771
- Languages that have Scripture: 2,932; of these, 555 have an adequate Bible, 1,333 have an adequate New Testament, and 1,045 have at least one book of the Bible
- Total number of languages in which Bible translation is in progress: 2,771
