Hacksaw Ridge is the amazing story of Desmond Doss and his courageous selflessness in walking into enemy fire over and over again to "save one more." All of us were in an even more desperate place than the wounded men stranded on that ridge; we needed to be rescued by Christ from sin, emptiness, corruption, selfishness, deception, and hell. We were rescued because Jesus came "to seek and to save the lost" (Luke 19:10). He has given us the same mission.

People around us are in need of rescue. They are lost! As Desmond showed incredible courage and urgency to save other soldiers, God is calling us to feel an urgency and to courageously take risks to rescue the lost.

SPOTLIGHT ON MISSIONS HOW YOUR GIVING IS CHANGING THE WORLD

Through your giving at Harvest, you are contributing to the spread of the gospel in Bosnia (southeast Europe). This week at Harvest we were honored to have the pastor of Pentecostal Evangelical Church of Breza share with us about his life and ministry. The hardships that he faced growing up in Bosnia are impossible for us to imagine. It was in 1999 through the witness of American missionaries that he became the only Christian in his entire city. Less than four years later, he was pastoring a new church in Breza (near Sarajevo). Now, fifteen years later, he and his wife, continue to faithfully pastor the Breza Evangelical Church.

He coordinates humanitarian aid for families suffering from chronic underemployment (the need for aid is actually greater now than it was in the aftermath of the war that ended in 1996). The church partners with a faith-based drug rehab center. He also began a pastors fellowship, now a network of churches committed to each other and to a common vision for extending the kingdom of God. It is vital for church leaders to work together in unity and to persevere in preaching the gospel. In Bosnia, Christians are a tiny minority in a sea of Islam because the people identify as Muslim. The cultural expectation is that to be Bosnian is to be Muslim. This Islamic nationalism has long been a barrier to leading people to Jesus, and can be a real discouragement for Christians.

Please pray for him, the other pastors, the growth of the churches, and for their example of unity and love to become a model for other struggling churches in this hard to reach nation.
