FROM PASTOR RALPH...



Just as we face different challenges at different times in the material world, we also face different challenges in the spiritual realm. It seems clear to our leaders that currently **marriages** are under attack. We have an enemy that kills, steals, and destroys (John 10:10), and a common tactic is to divide. The Lord is greater than our enemy, but we have to fight the battle and resist the enemy. (1 John 4:4, 1 Peter 5:8-9). So stop right now and pray for the marriages of Harvest Church. If you're single, pray, because we're all in this together.

There are several important things for those who are married to know:

1. **If you love God, you love your spouse.** It's a package deal. You can't love God and not love your spouse.
2. **Fight!** We have a real enemy, and we're in a real battle.
3. **Stay on the same team.** The enemy divides and wants spouses to see each other as the enemy. *Do not give in to that!* Stay on the same team no matter what.
4. **Pray together.** Several years ago, Focus on the Family researchers found that only one out of a thousand couples who pray together daily get divorced. Pray together today! Don't know how to pray out loud? Learn. You're in a battle. Fight for your marriage! If you're single, fight in prayer on behalf of the marriages of our church.
5. **Get rid of any obstacles** to your relationship with your spouse and with God.
6. **Determine to encourage, build up, and pray for your spouse.** Think of ways to do it!

For most people, summer is a time when there's more time for family. Bring the Lord into your family every way you can, so He can bless your family this summer!

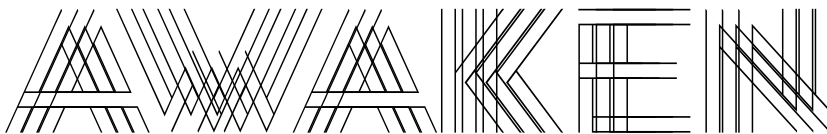
Students have morning devotionals, daily service projects, and nightly sessions with worship and teaching. Please note: there will be no youth small groups or Wednesday night service during WIRED week.
