From Pastor Ralph...



Many of us have experienced a GREAT START to 2019! But what do you do if things start going bad, or rather *when* things start going bad? Trials are sure to come. Satan is real and will always counter-attack when we're making progress.

What do you do when your thoughts, feelings, words, or circumstances bring discouragement? Remember:

1 Your feelings matter, but don't define you. No one this side of Heaven feels good all the time.

2 Faith (which is more precious than gold — 1 Peter 1:7) grows in storms.

3 Satan is at work, but so is God! See Romans 8:28, 31, 37; Romans 5:3-5; Romans 16:20; Philippians 4:19; James 1:2-4; and 2 Peter 1:3-4.

4 Discouragement never comes from God! It is a primary weapon of our enemy, so resist it!

5 You have weapons as well: time in prayer and in the Bible are especially important in hard times. Small group connection is very important. Stay open with your group. Let them know you're discouraged and ask them to pray for you. Keep working your Plan for Spiritual Growth. Remember that worship, praise, and thanksgiving are powerful in defeating discouragement and depression!

God knows what you're going through and He is faithful to make a way for your victory. Great things are coming through the Freedom groups and Freedom Conference (April 26-27), Plan for Spiritual Growth, your commitment to pray for and share with your faith with 5 people who need Jesus, Easter Sunday (April 21), and our Spiritual Life Conference (May 5-8). As you rely on Christ to overcome attacks, you will get stronger in your soul and spirit. You will bring glory to God, live with more joy, faith, confidence, and be better equipped to make an eternal difference with your life.

Be encouraged! The victory is ours in the Lord!

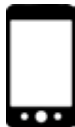

How to Find Rooms at Harvest / Wheelchair Access

- **Building A:** Worship Center, main lobby, main kitchen, Prayer Room, Mothers Room. Meetings rooms are identified as A105, A106, etc.
 - **Building B (Education Building):** Noah's Park (nursery), Youth Room, KZ (K-4th grade), small group rooms. Meeting rooms are identified on 1st floor as B105, B106, etc. and on the 2nd floor as B205, B206, etc. The elevator is just past the Noah's Park check-in desk.
 - **Building C (New Small Group Building):** Fellowship Hall, Chapel, small group rooms. Meetings rooms (all on 2nd floor) are identified as C225, C226, etc. The elevator is at the front of the building closest to Building B (Press 1 for Chapel or Fellowship Hall; Press 2 for 2nd floor meeting rooms; Press 1R for 1st floor of Building B (nursery); Press 2R for 2nd floor of Building B (children/youth/meeting rooms)).
 - **Wheelchair Access to Building C:** There is no wheelchair access from the back parking lot. There are handicap parking spots in the front parking lot; enter through Building A (Worship Center). From the main lobby, turn left down the hallway to Building B, and turn right down the hallway in Building B to enter Building C. Wheelchair drop off is at the drive-through on the creekside of Building B. Once inside, turn left down the hallway which connects to Building C. The elevator is directly in front of you as you enter Building C through the double doors. Press 1 to go to the Fellowship Hall or Chapel; Press 2 to go to the 2nd floor meetings rooms. When you leave, press 1R to return to Building B.
